Section 5.04.520 Retail Sales and Miscellaneous. Any person conducting or carrying on the business of selling at retail, any goods, wares, merchandise or commodities, or conducting or carrying on any trade, occupation, or business not otherwise specifically licensed by other sections of this article, shall pay an annual license tax of:

\$25.00 for the first employee plus \$2.00 for each additional employee, maximum license tax of \$100.00.

Section 5.04.500 Manufacturing, Processing, and Wholesaling. Every person conducting or carrying on the business consisting of manufacturing, packing, processing or selling at wholesale, any goods, wares, merchandise and or commodities, at a fixed place of business within the City of Orland or conducting or carrying on the business of cold storage or refrigeration plant, shall pay an annual license tax as follows:

\$15.00 for the first employee; plus \$2.00 for each employee. Maximum license tax is \$100.00.

Section 5.04.370 Enumeration of Businesses and Professions. Every person conducting or carrying on any business, profession, or occupation enumerated in the Orland Municipal Code, shall pay an annual license tax based on each professional member and the average number of employees computed as follows:

The first person practicing said profession, other than as a employee, \$30.00. For each additional person practicing said profession, other than as a salaried employee, \$15.00. Each employee in addition to the above, \$2.00. Maximum license tax \$100.00.

Section 5.04.510 Real Estate Brokers, Agents. Every person conducting or carrying on the business of real estate broker, broker-salesman, salesman or agent, shall pay an annual license tax computed as follows:

\$25.00 for each real estate broker in the firm; \$10.00 for each broker-salesman, salesman or agent, and \$2.00 for each additional person employed.

Section 5.04.460 General Contractors, Subcontractors, and Specialty Contractors.

- a. Every person conducting or carrying on the business of a general contractor or building contractor shall pay a license tax fee of \$30.00 per annum, plus \$2.00 for each employee in excess of two (2).
- b. Every person conducting or carrying on the business of electrical, plumbing, or painting subcontractor, a license tax of \$25.00 per annum, plus \$2.00 per employee in excess of two (2).
- c. Every person conducting or carrying on the business of specialty contractor or any other contractor not specifically mentioned in this section, a license tax of \$20.00 per annum, plus \$2.00 per employee in excess of two (2).
- d. Every person conducting or carrying on the business of house moving, grading, paving, wrecking, sewer pipeline, trenching, or excavating contractor, a license tax of \$50.00 per annum, plus \$2.00 per employee in excess of two (2). Maximum license tax under this section shall be \$100.00
